We are optimistic they will, and the stars will align for Summer 2021 at Wahanowin. We ask that you do, what we have continued to do: keep your eye on the prize and continue to #planforcamp.

We have created our COVID-19 plan (in Q&A format) and are ready to share it with you. Please keep in mind that it has been developed with **WHAT WE KNOW RIGHT NOW** and is subject to change. Because of this, we feel it is important to gather as a community at a later date. We will let you know once new dates have been scheduled, sometime in May.

- **Activities:** All activities at camp will be in operation on a schedule! Our summer programming team will be on-site to offer unique Wahanowin family programming.
