**1) Camp Forms**

Camp forms will be made available later this week through the Registration Portal and must be completed by **Monday, June 7<sup>th</sup>**.

**2) An invoice/statement of your account**

Your final payment is due in full on **Tuesday, June 1<sup>st</sup>** (*this does not apply to families on our 6-month instalment plan*). Your invoice/statement will include the COVID-19 testing surcharge that we indicated on our COVID-19 webpage of \$475/camper, plus tax and a \$100 credit for 1-way busing only (*\$50 credit for Wahano-Week campers*). CITs and CIT-Staff participants will have regular, 2-way busing, and therefore no credit will be applied.

**3) An invitation to our postponed Family Virtual Flagpole on Zoom**

This will take place on **Tuesday, June 8<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm** where our panel of experts (Directors and Health Care Professionals) will answer your most frequently asked questions related to COVID-19 and Summer 2021 at Wahanowin.
